NOTE: No more than two urns or boxes may be buried on a lot of another interment if the name can be cut on the existing stone or no name is requested. A separate grave must be used if a marker is requested.

Grave sizes and lot sizes vary according to cemetery and location

There will be no burials, opening/closings or disint ernenments of any type on any of the federal holidays or Sundays.

FOUNDATIONS: Foundations are figured at .50 cents per sq. inch. This will be the base size plus a 4” border added to all 4 sides. All markers require a foundation. Foundations will be installed quarterly or at the discretion of the Superintendent. **Veteran foundations will be installed at no cost.**

Township employees or agents of the township shall perform all labor. This includes, but is not limited to the placing of monuments and markers, construction of concrete foundations, excavating and backfilling graves, trimming trees and shrubs and mowing grass. Any item placed in the cemetery that is inconsistent with these rules and regulations, or that has not been approved by the Board, shall be removed without notice.

Animals and pets are not permitted in the cemetery, unless used to assist the disabled

FLOWERS AND DECORATIONS: Fresh and artificial flowers will be removed after seven days. Seasonal artificial decorations in good condition are permitted on monument stones only (or extensions where applicable) when securely attached or in permanently installed urns or vases and do not interfere with cemetery maintenance.

- The concrete border surrounding memorials is placed to aid in the maintenance of the grass and offers protection from damage by the mowing equipment. Floral or any other decoration placed on this border negates its intentions and may create a hazard and therefore will be removed.
- The use of wire, iron or steel to secure decorations in place is prohibited as well as shepherd hooks.
- The placing of cemetery boxes, toys, shells, ornaments, bottles, vases, glass, wood or iron cases, plastic blocks, Styrofoam, artificial animals, tin cans, wire, crockery, and any bric-a-brac of any description will not be permitted.

The cemetery reserves the right of preventing or removal of all floral designs, structures and objects of any kind from the cemetery if in the judgement of the Superintendent they shall be deemed inappropriate to the overall aesthetics of the cemetery. No trees or bushes are to be placed or planted in any part of the cemetery. The Trustees assume no liability for vandalism or any removal of flowers.

MONUMENTS: The Trustees assume no liability for any damaged monuments. All upright monuments are to be placed to the rear of the grave. All flat markers stones are placed to the front of the grave (referred to as the head of the grave). Only one upright marker will be permitted per grave.

INDIGENTS: If Indigent residency is established. Madison Township will take responsibility for the preparation and internment of the indigent at a minimum cost to Madison Township while still adhering to accepted minimum terms of internment.

Our cemeteries are open to the public from dusk to dawn each day.
